Then, the two-word Domains were registered in the 1998-2000 timeframe. Thereafter, the market exploded into millions of Domains of every type. For example, familyvalues.com might be worth \$50 to a family who want to promote themselves, or \$5,000 to a new business selling to families, or \$5 million to a conservative billionaire who wants to dedicate his/her life to promoting family values as the cornerstone of democracy and freedom.

A new factor in the domain market is the entry of companies from China and India in the U.S. marketplace, looking for quality dot-com domains.
